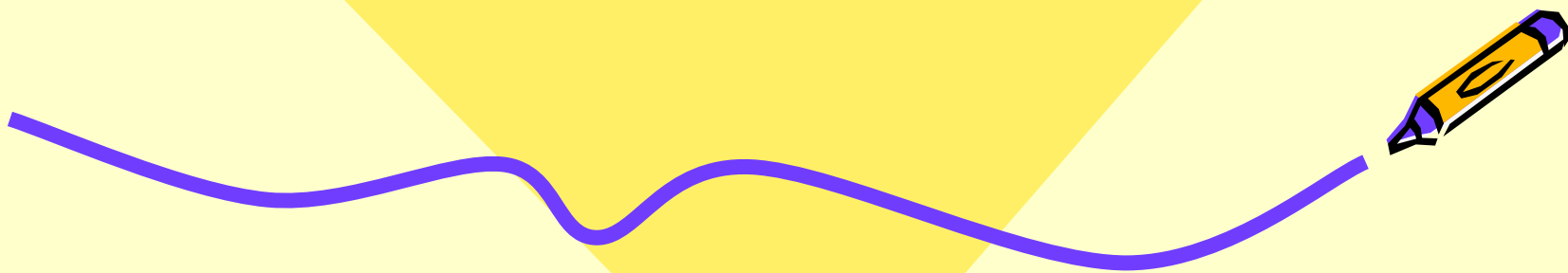
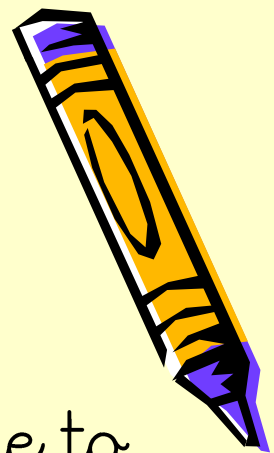

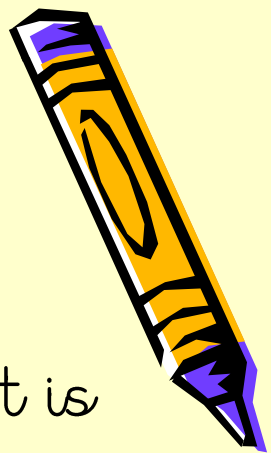
# Folders

- If your child requires any medicine, please take it to the office and fill in the form.



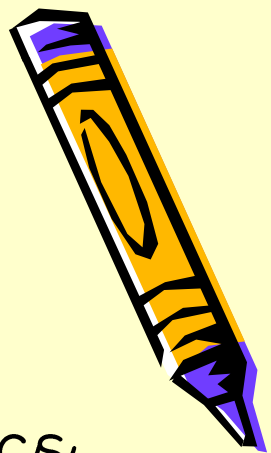
# Phonics Screening

- A national initiative to assess year one children. It is nothing to worry about!
- It is done by us in class time next May/June.
- It is checking all of the Letters and Sounds your child has learnt during reception and year 1.
- It is to check their reading skills and ability to segment and blend sounds.

- There will be a meeting in the Spring term to share ways to support your child at home.



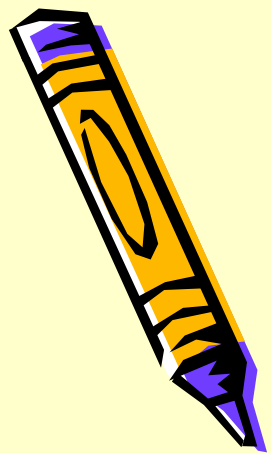
# Spellings

- Children will also have a login for The Spelling Shed to use at home.



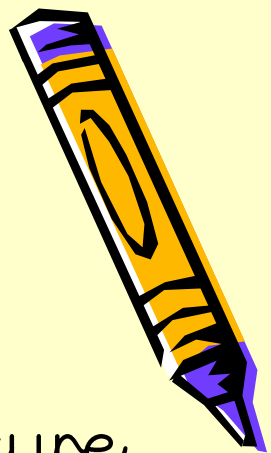
# Intervention

- Do NOT be alarmed!

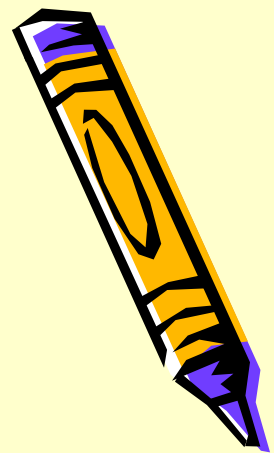


# PE

- Earrings - must be removed at home for swimming and PE.

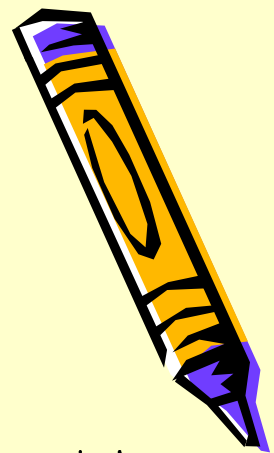


# Forest School

Starting this Friday

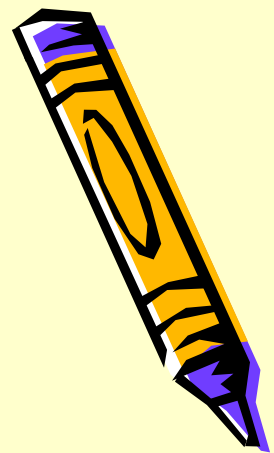
- Led by specialist Forest School leader Mr Fox
- Parents are invited to the final session (AM/PM)





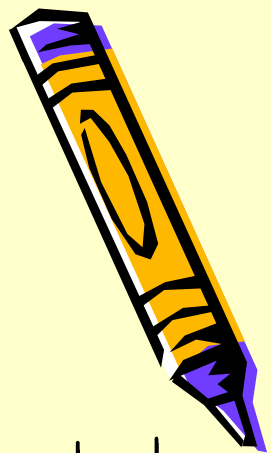
