

All of our work for the next two weeks is based around the book 'Don't hog the hedge!' Please find todays learning tasks below.

It takes Hattie 23 days to find all of the leaves she will need to hibernate. It also takes her 15 days to find the sticks to make her den.

Finding the food she needs for winter takes 12 days less than the total time it takes to find the leaves and sticks.
