


Year 2

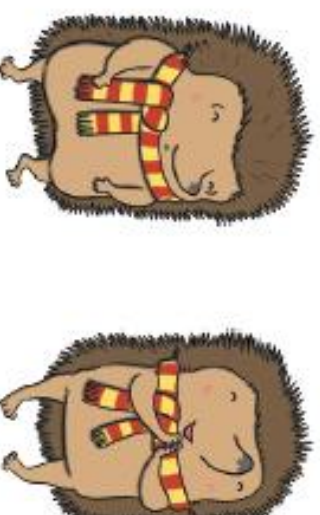
