



<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Explore traditional tales using drama, character description and setting descriptions. This will lead to rewriting a traditional tale using adjectives, conjunctions and embedding our non-negotiables.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We start by learning about 2D and 3D shapes, naming them, knowing their properties and lines of symmetry. We will then move to place value where we will; read, write, partition and recognise numbers up to 100. Learning the 10 times tables will be a big focus this term.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>We shall be learning about the history of Knypersley as well as the human and physical features and what makes Knypersley special and unique. We will learn who John and James Bateman are and their importance to the history of Knypersley.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will learn about the difference between human and physical features. We will go on a walk around our local area to recognise these. We will also use a map of the United Kingdom to locate its countries.</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>We will be learning about humans and labelling their body parts. We will describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right food and hygiene</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>This term, we will focus on being able to use word processing software to type simple sentences. We will learn how to save and reopen a document and the importance of naming a file.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>We will be focussing on drawing and painting skills this term. We will learn about how to add detail to our drawings using graded sketching pencils and experiment creating texture with paint.</p>	<p><u>DT</u></p> <p>We will be learning the cut, shape, fold and curl materials using scissors. We will experiment with different joining techniques such as hinges and gluing. We will learn how to strengthen materials.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will be learning to play the glockenspiel this term. We will learn about the different pitches that the notes make and how to make a louder or quieter sound. We will also practise our Christmas nativity.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will learn about the importance of looking after our world and link this to the Christian faith as Christians believe that God gave them the world to look after. We will learn about the bible and why it is read.</p>	<p><u>PSHRE</u></p> <p>We will learn about the qualities of a good friend and how to maintain positive relationships both online and offline. We will know how to share our opinions and that recognise that not everybody believes the same.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching. Participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. In Autumn 2, we will move onto dance and learn to create simple dance patterns and routines ensuring that we have move with control.</p>
