
Reading Challenge!

week of term.





I am pleased to let you know that the Rotary Club of Biddulph is again, running its Christmas card painting competition! The competition is open to children in 2 groups. Group 1, is for years 1 and 2 pupils and group 2, is for years 3 and 4 pupils. As usual, the theme for the competition will be 'Christmas Greetings Cards' and you may choose to create this using a contemporary or traditional design. The Rotary Club kindly ask that all entries are made from a piece of A4 card folded in half.
6 entries from each year group will then represent our school and be submitted to the Rotary Club for the final judg- ing. Every pupil whose entry reaches this stage will receive a Certificate of Participation in recognition of their efforts. These entries will be publically displayed, on the night of the Biddulph lights switch on (Saturday 26th November), in Santa Claus' Christmas Grotto, in the Town Hall! The winning Christmas card designs will be selected by Santa Claus and prizes for the best three entries in each final group include a framed certificate and book tokens to the value of £25,£20 and £15.
A representative from the Rotary Club will collect the 6 entries from each year group, on Wednesday 16 th November. Therefore, as a school, we kindly request <u>that all submissions are returned to school no later than Tuesday 15th</u> <u>November</u> , so that we can begin to make the hard decision of which designs should proudly represent our school!
