Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our theme "Unsinkable," all about The Titanic, Year 2 will be going on a very exciting visit to the Maritime Museum in Liverpool. The museum has an exhibit all about the Titanic and as part of this visit the children will also be taking part in a workshop in the museum. This workshop is specifically aimed at children in Key Stage One, where the history of the Titanic will be told through story telling activities. This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to really immerse themselves in the history of the Titanic and to also see some artefacts first hand.

We will be visiting the museum on Wednesday 1st March 2023. We will leave school just before 9am so the children will need to be in school no later than 8.45am, as we will be leaving promptly. Your child will need to wear full school uniform, with sensible shoes and a warm/waterproof jacket as there will be some outside walking on the day. Your child will need either a fully disposable packed lunch from home, or they can alternatively have a free packed lunch from school. Please indicate if your child will require a school packed lunch below.

Please send your child on the day with a small back pack, so that they can carry their lunch and an additional water bottle for the day.

We will aim to be back for the end of the usual school day, traffic dependent, but we will stay in touch with you on the day.

We kindly ask if you are able to make a voluntary contribution of **£4.30** for this visit. This will cover the cost of the museum workshop and insurance. Our wonderful P.T.F.A have agreed to pay for the cost of the coach for us, therefore reducing the price of the visit to parents considerably. The payment will be on Parent Pay.
