What is PSHRE?





Personal - ourselves.

 Social - interactions and relationships with others.

Health - looking after our bodies (physically and mentally).

 Relationships - keeping ourselves safe and respecting others.

Economic - about money.

Preparing us with life skills for school, home and in the community.

We cover the key concepts and skills that underpin PSHRE Education to support pupils' spiritual, moral, cultural, mental and physical development and prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities

We help pupils develop and demonstrate skills and attitudes that will allow them to participate fully in and contribute positively to life in modern Britain.

Pupils will also be taught through three underlying core themes, within which there will be broad overlap and flexibility:-
