



English

We will continue to embed our nonnegotiables when writing sentences.

We will learn to use conjunctions and adjectives.

We will listen to and recount stories.

We will listen to and write poetry.

Maths

We will recognise and name 2d and 3d shapes. We will count, read, recognise, write and represent numbers to 20. We will represent and use number bonds to 20. We will Add and subtract I and 2 digit numbers to 20 and solve problems involving this. We will compare and measure length and height and mass and volume.

History

We will learn about monarchs and their duty. We will learn about our current Royal family. We will learn about King Charles III, Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria.

We will order the Monarchs in chronological order.

Geography

We will learn to locate and name the four countries of the United Kingdom (UK). We will learn to describe the characteristics of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. We will learn to locate and name the four seas that surround the UK.

Science

We will learn to observe changes across the seasons. We will learn about plants. We will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants and trees. We will identify and describe the basic structure of common flowering plants, including trees. We will work scientifically.

Computing

We will learn to type on a keyboard and select and edit text. We will learn that many everyday objects respond to a command. We will give and follow instructions, one at a time. We will begin to understand what cyberbullying is and how to protect ourselves with the SMART rules.

Art

We will learn how to use and hold a paintbrush correctly and we will learn that different tools create different effects. We will learn that there are three primary colours and that if we mix 2 primary colours, we will make a secondary colour. We will learn that texture describes how something looks/feels and how to create different textures.

PE

We will learn to perform dance using simple movement patterns. We will remember basic dance steps, linking movement to sound. We will learn how to control basic movements, core body shapes, balances, rolls and a 2 footed jump. We will learn how to link movements in a sequence.

Music

We will listen to and appraise different songs. We will play games, learn to sing songs, play instruments with the songs, improvise with the songs. We will then perform the songs.

RE

We will learn about how people show that they can care and how faith communities show that they care.

We will think about why believers care for others and who we care for. We will learn about who we can turn to and who turned to God.

We will learn about what believers learn from God.

PSHRE

We will learn about personal hygiene, healthy eating and the importance of exercise. We will also learn about fair and unfair, bullying and how we can keep emotionally safe.

DT

We will be learning about structures by exploring existing seats and use construction toys and materials to make a free-standing structure. We will explore ways to fold/join to make structures stronger and stiffer. We will plan, design and make o throne.
