Year I Forest School

We are pleased to inform you that your child will take part in Forest School sessions on Fridays this term.

Please can your child come dressed for Forest School. The sessions will be led by a trained Forest School leader. By taking the children outside it encourages them to learn social, physical and educational skills whilst appreciating and understanding the woodland environment through a wide variety of activities and tasks geared for them. Activities include observing nature, making natural artwork, building shelters, using tools to make items with for example, cooking on a fire. The sessions are intended to be fun as well as giving the children a chance to learn in a safe environment.

Unfortunately, as this is England with very changeable weather it is impossible to say if it will be raining, snowing or sunny so please watch the weather forecast and then dress them appropriately.

Please could you send your child into school on a Friday in old/outdoor clothes, wellies or boots ready to explore the outdoors. Please also supply their PE kit and trainers in a plastic bag for after the session in case they get too muddy!
