Dear Parents/Carers,

This letter is regarding some final information that you need before our trip to Standon Bowers on 06/03/23.

With regards to the morning of Monday 6th March, we ask that you arrive at 8:30am through the school office entrance. You will be invited to accompany your child into the hall as we carry out final preparations to leave for Standon Bowers (including the collection of money, medication and snacks – see below). When our coach arrives, we will ask you to make your way outside before we guide the children on to the coach.

In accordance with Standon Bowers' guidelines, can we please ask that your child **DOES NOT** bring any aerosol sprays such as deodorant or hairspray.

The "tuck shop" at Standon Bowers only provides small souvenirs, not food. Because of this, can you please provide your child with their preferred snack for the evening times, such as crisps, biscuits, a small bag of sweets or a chocolate bar. This must only be **one small snack per night (two snacks in total)**. Could this please be provided in a named, disposable bag separate from your child's main luggage. We will collect these in on Monday morning to store them for the journey. Please **DO NOT** send any items containing nuts, however if it is labelled '**may contain**' it is acceptable.

The souvenirs available have been listed on a tuck shop document on our class page <https://www.knypersley.staffs.sch.uk/year-4/>. If you wish your child to purchase any of these, please send them with no more than £5 in a named envelope that can be handed in to Year 4 staff on Monday morning.

If your child will be taking medication with them to Standon Bowers, could we please ask that you hand your medications to a staff member on Monday morning in a clearly labelled container. If your child has a Salbutamol inhaler in school, we will be taking it with us so you don't need to provide an additional one.
