



Our Curriculum is driven by geography and history

- In geography we will learn about the different biomes around the world, as well as the mountains and finally the culture of Fairtrade.
- In history we will learn skills and knowledge around the concepts of everyday life/ culture, legacy and trade when learning about the Viking-Anglo-Saxon struggle for the UK, the Roman Empire in Britain and Ancient Maya.
- We will also study a range of skills and knowledge through our other non-core subjects, such as RE, ART, D&T etc.

Reading

- •Children are individually heard to read at least once a week.
- •There will also be reading in Good Morning Work, sometimes with a reading buddy.
- Children will take part in ERIC sessions three times a week, to promote the joy of reading.
- •The focus in Year 4 is reading for understanding and inference.
- Another big focus for this year is written comprehension.
- To promote a love of reading, we will visit our school library each week to select a book to share.

Writing in Year Four



In Year 4, the main focus of our English lessons will be to write a variety of different sentence types, such as embedded clauses and expanded noun phrases. We will enjoy lots of fabulous stories to inspire our writing and gather lots of high-level language.

Spellings

- Spellings will be linked to our phonics work or spelling rule on Spelling Shed.
- Spelling of the common exception words is a big focus across the school.
- Children will also have a login for The Spelling Shed to use at home, with games that link to their spelling words. We will update these every Friday.

Maths

- The children are given lots of opportunities to explore new maths learning through discussions with partners and in groups; using equipment to support their understanding.
- We encourage the children to represent their working out using concrete resources, pictorially, using abstract methods and then demonstrate their depth of understanding when exploring reasoning and problemsolving challenges.
- In year 4, the children are encouraged to know their number facts to 1000.



Multiplication Check

- At Knypersley, we promote the importance of multiplication through fun games and songs.
- In June, all Year 4 children take part in a nationwide multiplication check.
- This covers all times tables from 2x table up to the 12x table with an expected 6 second recall.
- TT Rockstars, MathsFrame, Hit the button.

Intervention

- You may hear your child mention they have had some intervention. This sounds very formal. Please do not be alarmed.
- Intervention may take place to extend children as well as support them. Or we may even just need to tackle an individual issue with your child- it does not mean we have a big issue. Our curriculum is just very personalised.
- If your child is completing an Intervention, you will receive a letter to explain.

Miss Leese - SENCo

- Supports with children with additional needs
- Helps teachers to plan appropriate provision and adapt any reasonable adjustments
 - Works with external agencies to provide quality, personalised interventions for children
- Miss Leese also works closely with the MHST to support children with anxiety or low mood.


