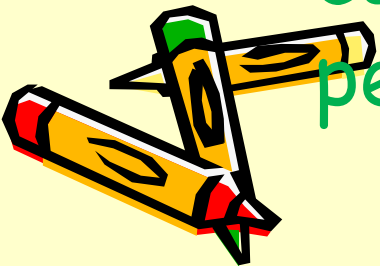
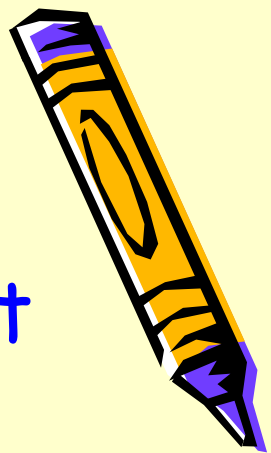


- You may receive a personalised pack of resources to help support your child's learning in school.
- Our half termly menu will be sent home in the pink homework books for you to complete a minimum of three tasks with your child.



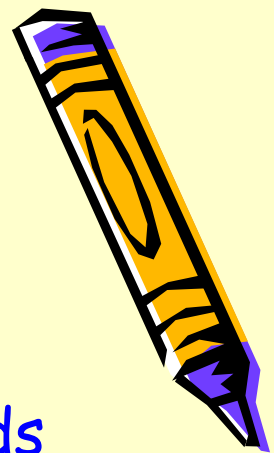
# Intervention

# Miss Leese - SEND Lead

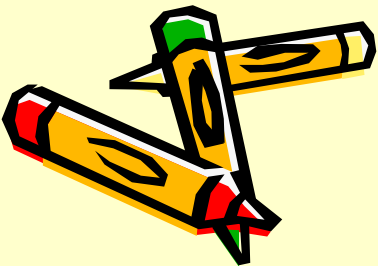
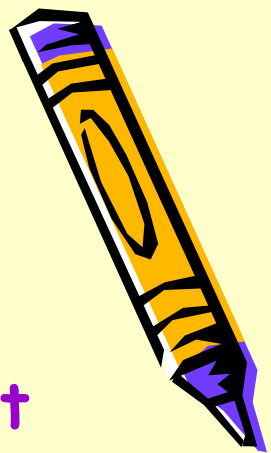
- Supports with children with additional needs

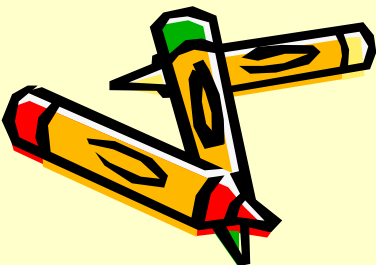


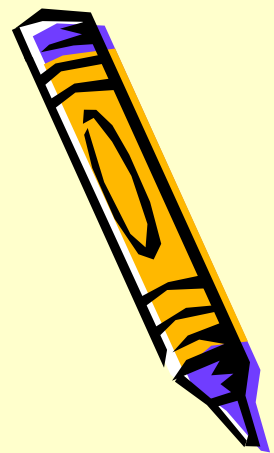

- Our wonderful PTFA organise lots of events and raise lots of money for our children-they would welcome new members.



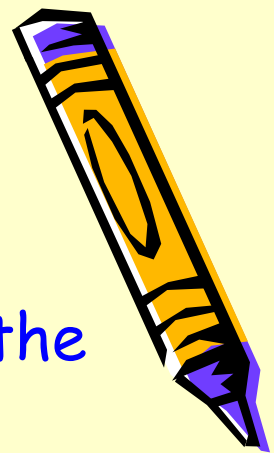

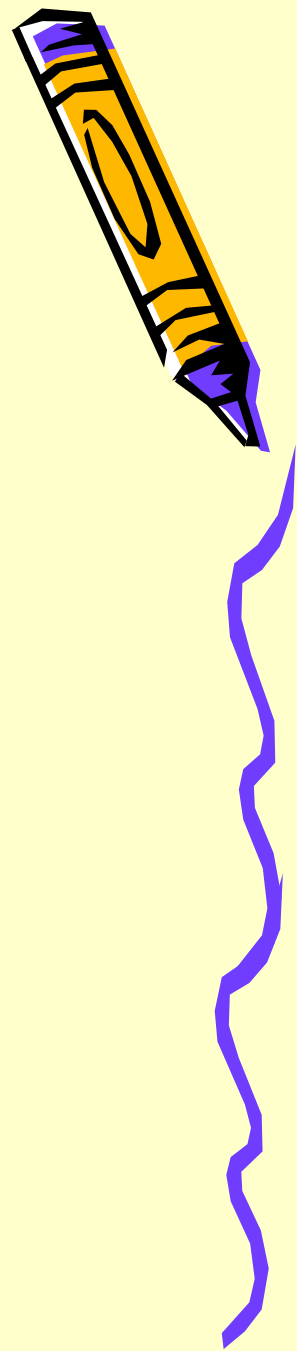
