Job Vacancy

We currently have vacancies at Knypersley for a cleaner and a lunchtime supervisor

If you are interested or know someone who may be please call the school office on 01782 973810 for an application pack.

Lunchtime supervisor – the position is term time only for 1 hour 15 mins per day with an hourly of £11.79

Cleaner – term time plus some hours during the school holidays, 10 hours per week with an hourly rate of £11.59

If your child is 3 by the 31st December 2023 please apply by: Monday 13th November 2023 via the school office to start in January 2024.

If your child is 3 by the 31st March 2024 please apply by: Monday 4th March 2024 via the school office to start in April 2024.

If your child is 3 by the 31st August 2024 please apply by: Monday 6th May 2024 via the school office to start in September 2024.

Reception Admission Dates

If your child turns 4 before September 2024, please apply by the 15th January 2024 via Staffordshire Admissions for a place in our Reception 2024 cohor. Admissions will open on 1st November 2023

Government Funded Hours

When turning three your child will become eligible for 15 free hours of childcare a week provided by the government.

In some cases families are entitled to up to 30 hours funding from the Government based on household income (to find out more please use the calculator on the Staffordshire webpage).
