#### PRICE CHANGES APRIL 2024

With effect from the 1st April 2024:

Our school meal prices will rise to £2.95 for a children in Key Stage 2 that pay for their meals.

The nursery wraparound fee will rise to  $\pounds 15.24$ . This will apply to you if you pay for additional hours outside of your funded hours (taking 15 hours to 30 hours).




