Dear Parents and Carers,

YEEHAW cowboys and cowgirls! What a jam-packed week it has been for Team Knypersley this week.

I need to say a HUGE thank you from Mrs Booth for your support during World Book Day yesterday. We raised over £70, this money will be used to replenish our school Reading Ranch. If you would like to make a donation towards the Reading Ranch then please feel free to do so. We will be ordering new books, new decorations and some cosy accessories to enhance our Love of Reading core offer.

Due to rising food costs, Edwards and Ward have increased the price of school lunches to **£3.20** from after Easter 2025. As always we will continue to monitor the standards of lunches and ensure that our children receive the best quality possible.

From the 1st April 2025 our hourly charges for top up hours in our school nursery will be £5.43 per hour. This will only affect children who are entitled to 15 hours and choose to pay to remain at school for the full day. If you require support with payments/ Parent Pay please speak to Mrs Taylor in the school office.

Preparations for Mr Bloor leaving us at Easter have begun, more details of the transition have been sent out to Class 4 parents/ carers yesterday via Arbor. Exciting news—It is nearly Science Week!

Science week will begin on **Monday 10th March** and there are lots of exciting activities planned! This year's theme is:

Change and Adapt

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On **Monday 10th March** our Early Years and Key Stage 1 children will be taking part in a very exciting workshop with the Cheshire Mobile Farm. Here, they will get to meet the animals including goats, sheep, chickens, giant rabbits etc. They will have a hands on experience and find out more about the features of these animals, their diets and how to care for them etc. This experience will link to their Science curriculum outcomes.

Year 3 will be spending the afternoon at James Bateman on Wednesday 12th March working in their science labs. When there, the children will be taking part in a dinosaur themed 'WOW Science' session which will link in with their rocks and fossils learning from the last half term. (They also said they would throw in some volcano fun!)

Year 4 will be visited by a scientist from Woodhouse Middle School, on Wednesday 19th March. The scientists will be showing the children some 'WOW Science' before helping them to grow their own crystals in egg shells which they will then be able to take home with them.

Throughout the week the teachers have planned a range of science experiments and tasks linked to this year's theme of 'Change and Adapt'. Please keep your eyes on our Facebook page to see what we all get up to over the week!
