Hi, I'm Karen, from the Mental health Support Team (MHST) working within Abbey Hulton Primary School.

I am an Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP) and my role involves supporting young people and their familied with mild to moderate mental health challenges using Low intensity cognitive behavioural therapy (LICBT). Together we work to identify and address difficult emotions and feelings.

I work in partnership with the school's Mental Health Lead to deliver a whole school approach to mental health; this includes educational workshops, groups, and training to reduce the stigma of mental health and improve outcomes for the whole school community.
