As we launch our new **Snack Stars** initiative, we know that introducing a wider range of fruits and vegetables can sometimes feel like a big step for little tastebuds. To support families, we wanted to highlight a brilliant local offer right here in our community.

Biddulph Youth & Community Zone provides **fresh fruit and vegetable bags for just £3.50**, available every Thursday. Each bag includes a different selection of produce each week, making it a lovely way to help children try new fruits and vegetables at home. Bags can be reserved in advance and collected between 12:30pm and 6pm.

This is a great way to extend your child's diet, explore new flavours together, and support our Snack Stars focus on healthy choices. Little changes at home make a big difference in school too.

Reminder to please clear any outstanding balances for **school meals, KidsZone, and Nursery** ASAP, or make payments towards them. If debts become regular and payments are not made, access to **meals and KidsZone** may be stopped to prevent debt building up over time.

OUR SNACK STARS ARE COMING!

As part of our commitment to being a Healthy Eating School, we know that encouraging children to make healthier snack choices can sometimes be a challenge. However, it's also a fantastic opportunity for them to try new foods and build positive habits.

What Are Snack Stars?

- Each class will have a Healthy Snack Chart.
- When all children in the class bring a healthy snack, the class earns a sticker on their chart.
- Once the class collects 15 stickers, they will be invited to choose a Snack Star from Miss Leese!



What Do the Snack Stars Do?

- The Snack Stars will stay in the classroom for the term.
- Their role is to encourage and reward healthy snack choices, helping children feel proud of their efforts.
- At the end of the term, the Snack Star is returned, and the class works together again to earn a new one for the following term.

The incentive will begin week beginning 8th January 2026. Between now and then, we encourage children to start introducing healthier snacks at home and at school so they feel ready to contribute to their class's success.

Importantly, this lead-up period also gives parents and carers time to drop in and speak with staff if they would like advice or support with integrating healthy snacks into their child's routine. We are here to help make this transition as smooth and positive as possible.
